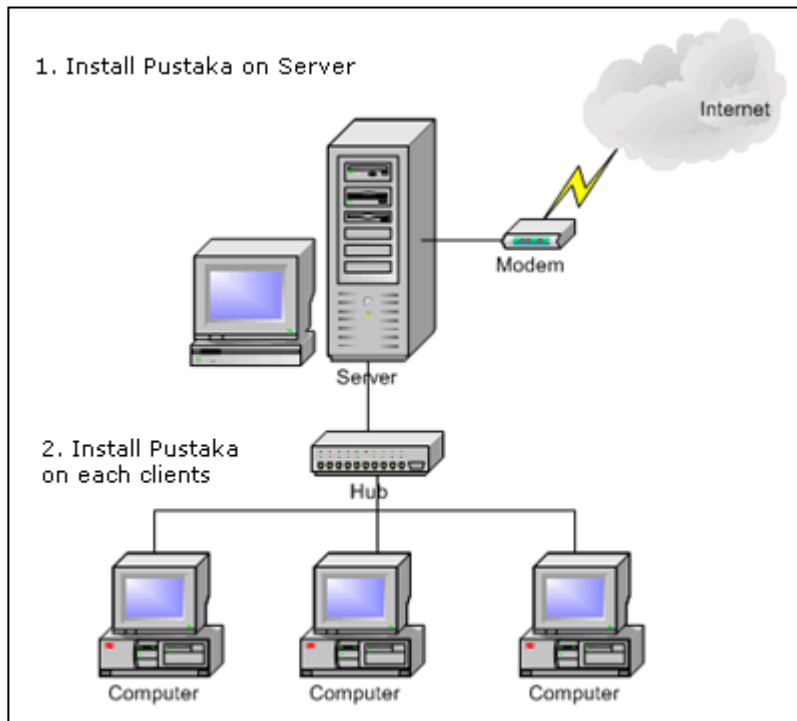


CLIENT-SERVER SETUP SECTION

Before installing Pustaka Advanced Edition, it is important to have some basic knowledge on the networking environment. Network is a group of two or more computers that are connected typically by network cables. In this group, there can be two types of computer: a server and a client. Server is a computer that provides the information whereas client is the computer that gets the information.

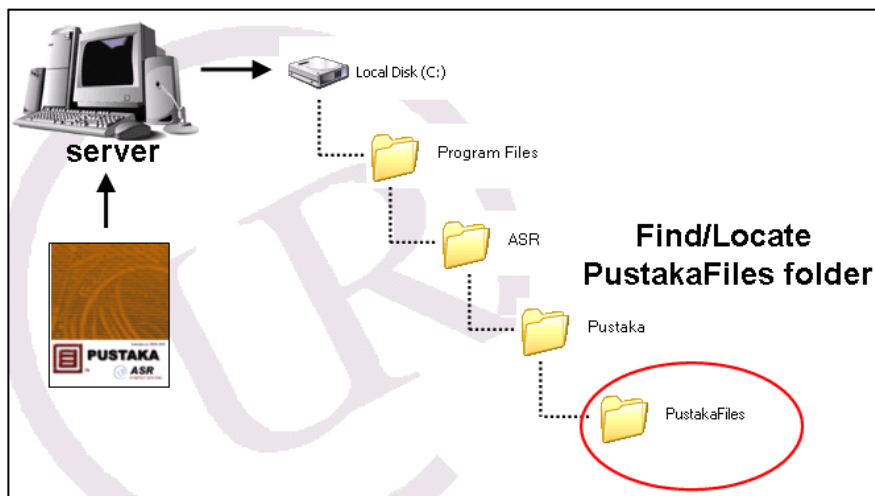
In a client/server network, the individual computers, called clients are linked to a central computer called a server. The server stores and distributes information to the client computer. **You need to know the domain name (server name) that you want to connect to.** This information can be obtained from your network administrator.

What we want to do next is : **install Pustaka on server and share a folder name PustakaFiles.** PustakaFiles is a folder that contain the database and image directory. By sharing this folder, clients can access this folder in the network environment. After that, we install Pustaka on the clients side and locate/find the PustakaFiles folder in the network.

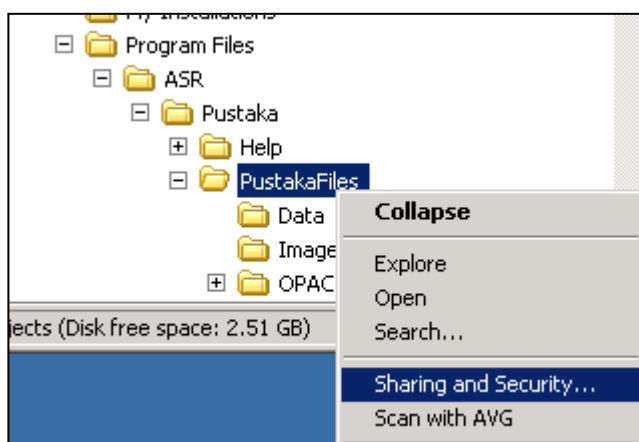


Install Pustaka on Server

1. Insert Pustaka CD and run the Setup. Refer chapter 2 on how to setup Pustaka.
2. Find folder PUSTAKAFILES. The default location is in : C:\Program Files\ASR\Pustaka\PustakaFiles

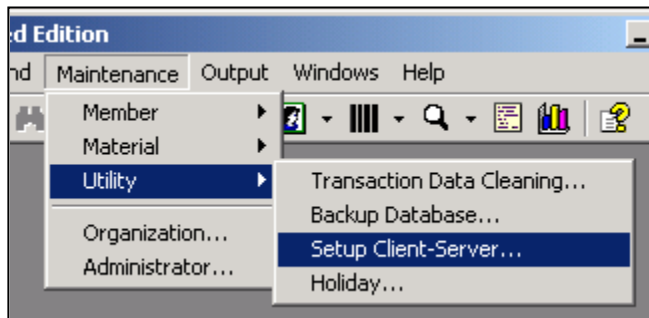


3. Share the PustakaFiles folder so that other clients can access this folder

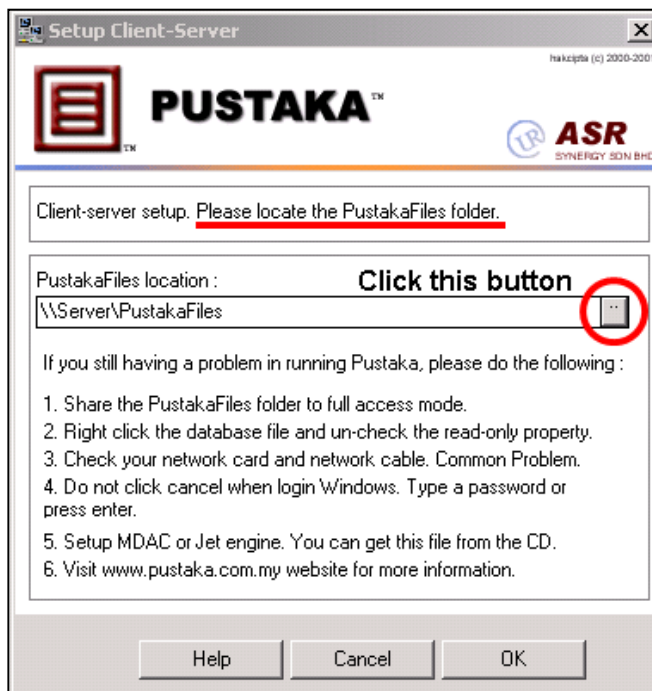


Install Pustaka on Clients

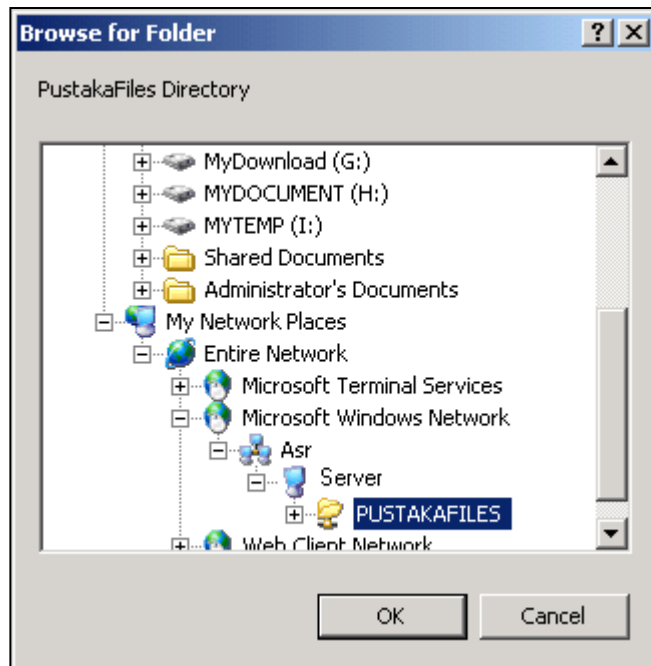
1. Insert Pustaka CD and run the Setup. Refer chapter 2 on how to setup Pustaka.
2. Go to menu Maintenance>Utility>Setup Client-Server



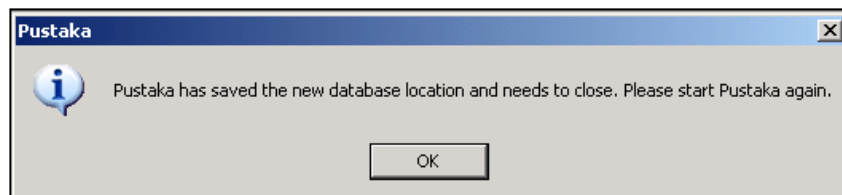
3. Click the triple dot button to find the PustakaFiles folder



4. Find PUSTAKAFILES folder that we have shared on the network and click OK



5. Restart Pustaka



6. Now, each clients will store the information on the server in shared folder PustakaFiles
