

OPAC SETUP SECTION

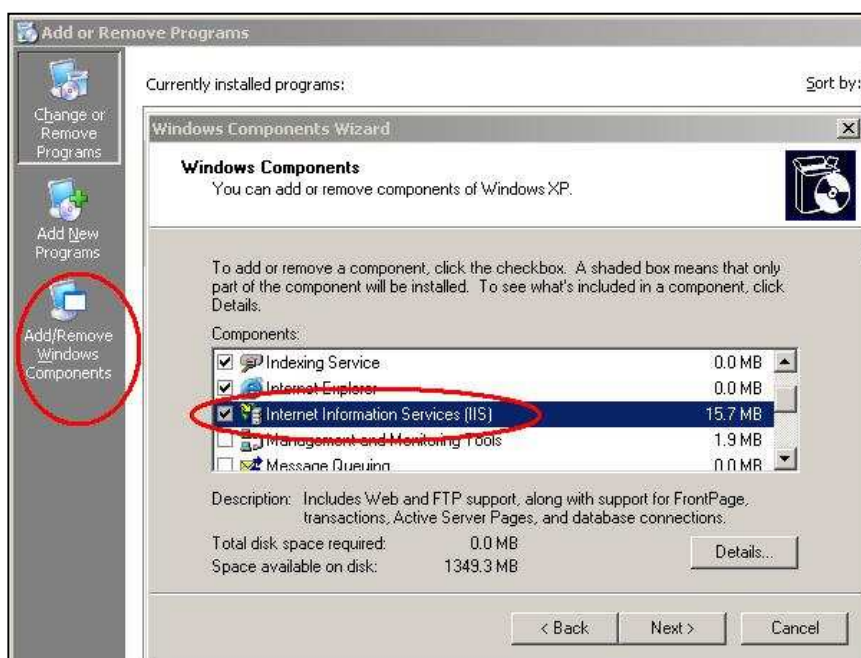
Please read client-server section on the user manual before proceed with this section.

In Client-Server section, you have shared the PustakaFiles folder on the server. The next step is how to setup OPAC on the server.

OPAC can only be installed on server side PC of Windows platform that support Internet Information Services (IIS) such as XP Professional, WinNT, Windows Server.

Installing IIS

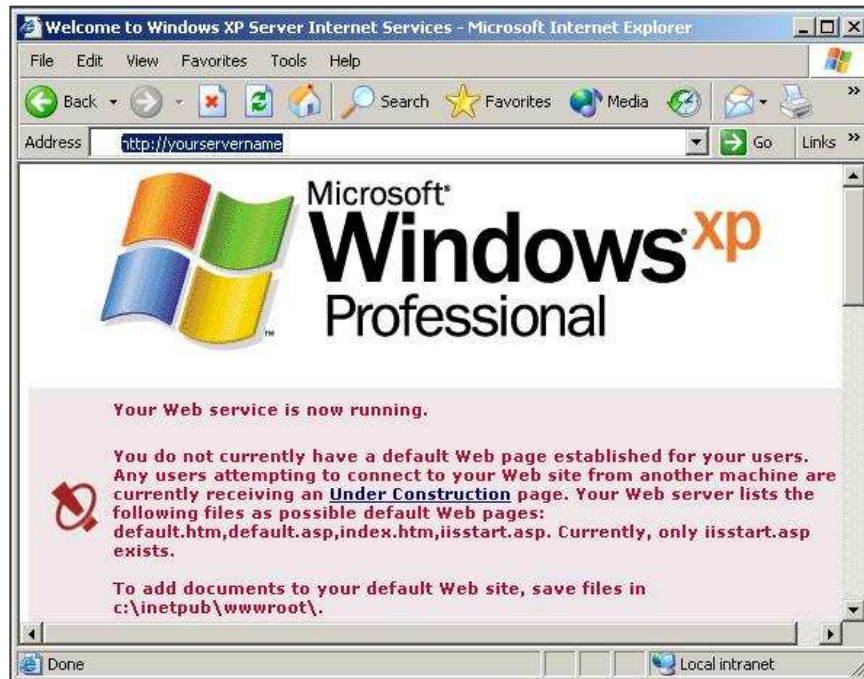
1. Click Start, click Control Panel, and double-click Add/Remove Programs.
2. In the left column of the Add/Remove Programs dialog box, click Add/Remove Windows Components.
3. When the Windows Components Wizard appears, click Next.
4. In the Windows Components list, select IIS.
5. Click Next, and follow the instructions.



Directories after installing IIS is C:\inetpub\wwwroot

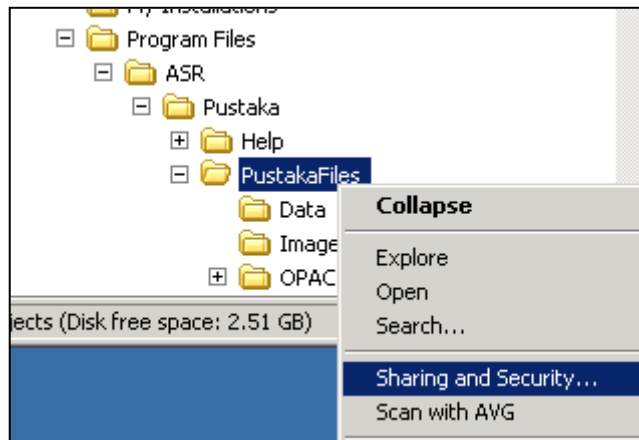
to check if you have install IIS successfully :

1. Run browser Internet Explorer
2. Type the following `http://localhost/` or `http://computename`
3. A welcome page mentioning your web service is now running will appear.



Configuring OPAC

1. The default location is C:\Program Files\ASR\Pustaka\PustakaFiles. However, we recommend the PustakaFiles folder to move into new location C:\PustakaFiles. Share the folder PustakaFiles on the server with full access mode.



2. Click Start>Settings>Control Panel>Administrative Tools>Internet Information Services



3. Expand the directory tree on the left column and right click Default Web Site
4. Choose New>Virtual Directory



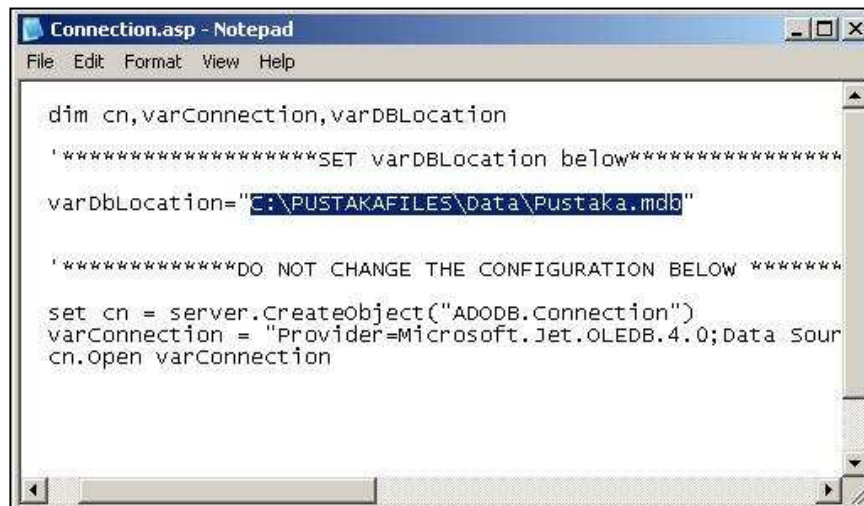
5. Type the alias OPAC
6. Type the PustakaFiles location (e.g C:\PustakaFiles)
7. Tick Read, Run scripts, Write for the access permissions



Configuring Database path

1. Go to directory C:\PustakaFiles\Opac\Include
2. Edit connection.asp using Notepad
3. Set Database location to the PustakaFiles location. For example :

C:\PustakaFiles\Data\Pustaka.mdb
F:\PustakaFiles\Data\Pustaka.mdb
C:\Program Files\ASR\Pustaka\PustakaFiles\Data\Pustaka.mdb

Run the OPAC

1. Run browser Internet Explorer
2. Type the following `http://localhost/opac` or `http://computername/opac`
3. OPAC page will appear
